

## **The Michelin S12**

With what everyone has said about this tire, I was so pumped to get it on the rim and go rip. Since I am no pro. it is hard for me to tell the small differences between each tire. I did however find this tire to be similar to the Dunlop 756 which I last talked about. I ride mostly at McNutt in Maple Ridge. This area has it all, rocks, mud pits, bigger mud pits, tons of roots and everything in between. I found the S12 to be an excellent tire on every type of terrain.

What I did notice however was that the S12 wore out a lot faster than my previous tire the Dunlop 756. Both these tires fall into the same price bracket at around \$145.00 Canadian and both tires seemed to me to ride similar. The Dunlop however set the standard for durability and I found the S12 did not stack up.

Since I won a tire at my last event I am running a soft Trac Master. This tire is gummy and I first rode it in the wicked trails of Kelowna, BC. Great tire....I will let you know how long it last.
